Talkgroup Management Policy

I. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure adequate talkgroups are available for all current and future Louisiana Wireless Information Network (LWIN) users.

II. Management

In order to provide necessary talkgroups to all current and future users of the LWIN system, talkgroups will be issued to agencies based on the number of radio subscriber units within the agency. A chart listing the number of talkgroups available by agency size is attached as Appendix A.

A. New Users

New Users may request any number of talkgroups up to the number provided for an agency in their size category.

B. Current Users

Current LWIN subscriber agencies will retain all assigned Talkgroups.

III. Exceptions

Agencies, whether new or current, may request additional talkgroups beyond the number allocated to agencies in their size category. Request will be made in writing to the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP) Office of Interoperability for presentation to the SIEC Technology Subcommittee for recommendation to the full SIEC. Every effort to limit the number of required talkgroups will be made by member agencies to ensure future availability of talkgroups for use by new users and expansion of the agency itself.
